

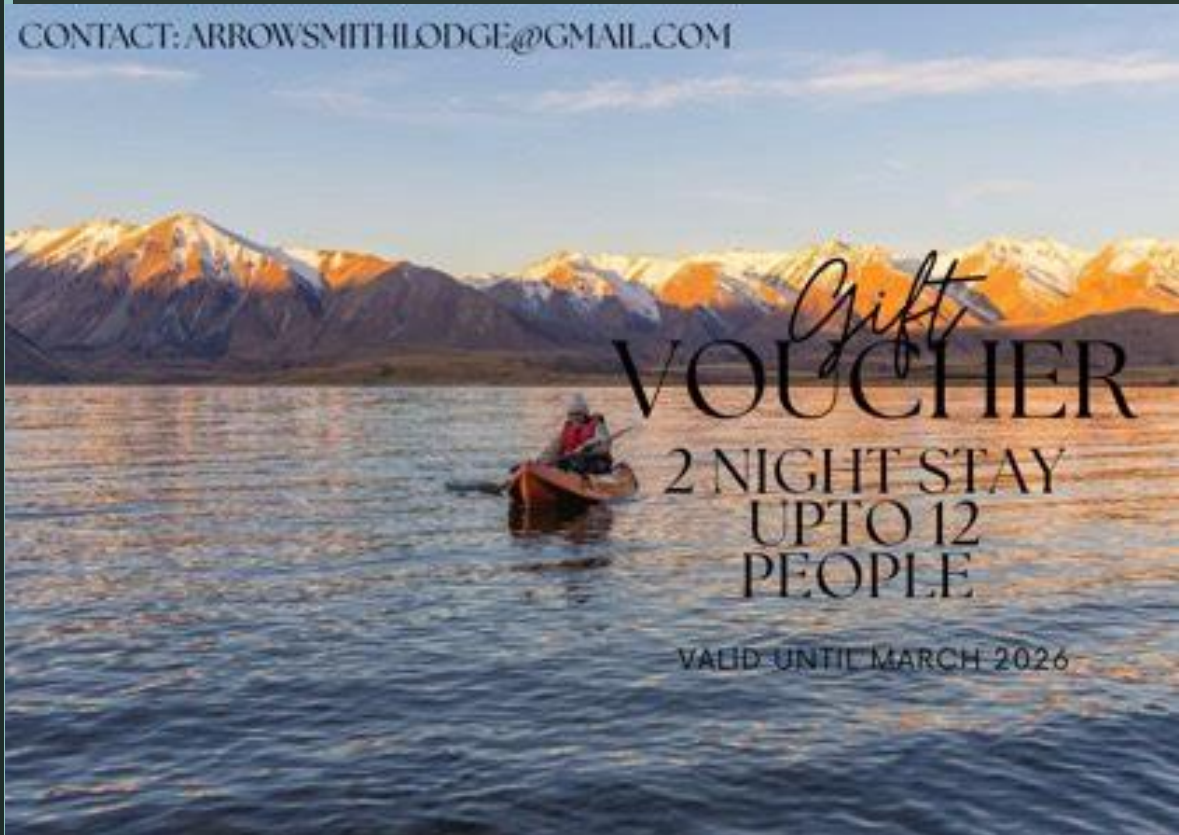

You will need to hold a current firearms licence, be proficient with a shotgun and have some gamebird/duck shooting experience for safety and for you to fully enjoy the day.
